OLD TESTAMENT:

Gen 1:1-3 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 The earth was formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit [h7307. רוּחַ רוּחַ Spirit] of God was moving over the surface of the waters. 3 Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

Gen 3:8 **They heard the sound** [h6963 Voice] **of the Lord God** walking in the garden in the cool [h7307. רוּחַ רוּחַ Spirit] of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence [h6440. פְּנִים pânîym face] of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

Ex 23:20-22 / John 14:2 10:4-5 "Behold, **I am going to send an angel before you** to guard you along the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. 21 Be on your guard before him and **obey His voice**; do not be rebellious toward him, for he will not *pardon* [to lift, bear up, carry, take] your transgression, since My name is in him. 22 **But if you truly obey His voice** and do all that I say, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries.

14:2 If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also. 4 And you know the way where I am going."

10:4 **When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice.** 5 A stranger they simply will not follow, but will flee from him, because they do not know the voice of strangers."

Deut 4:29-30 But from there you will seek the Lord your God, and you will find Him if you search for Him with all your heart and all your soul. 30 When you are in distress and all these things have come upon you, in the latter days you will return to the Lord your God and **listen to His voice.** [REV]

Deut 13:4 You shall follow the Lord your God and fear Him; and you shall keep His commandments, **listen to His voice**, serve Him, and cling to Him.

Deut 13:18 **if you will listen to the voice of the Lord your God**, keeping all His commandments which I am commanding you today, and doing what is right in the sight of the Lord your God.

Deut 26:17 You have today declared the Lord to be your God, and that you would walk in His ways and keep His statutes, His commandments and His ordinances, and **listen to His voice.**

Deut 30:19-20 / John 15:5 19 This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. **Now choose life**, so that you and your children may live 20 and that you may love the Lord your God, **listen to his voice**, and hold fast to him. **For the Lord is your life**, and he will give you many years in the land he swore to give to your fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

5 I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, **for apart from Me you can do nothing.**

Jos 24:24 The people said to Joshua, "We will serve the Lord our God and **we will obey His voice.**"

Ps 29:3-9 The voice of the Lord is upon the waters;

The God of glory thunders,

The Lord is over many waters.

4 The voice of the Lord is powerful,

The voice of the Lord is majestic.

5 The voice of the Lord breaks the cedars;

Yes, the Lord breaks in pieces the cedars of Lebanon.

6 He makes Lebanon skip like a calf,

And Sirion like a young wild ox.

7 The voice of the Lord hews out flames of fire.

8 The voice of the Lord shakes the wilderness;

The Lord shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.

The voice of the Lord makes the deer to calve

And strips the forests bare;

And in His temple everything says, "Glory!"

Ps 95:7-9 For He is our God,

And we are the people of His pasture and the sheep of His hand.

Today, if you would hear His voice,

8 Do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah,

As in the day of Massah in the wilderness,

9 "When your fathers tested Me,

Ps 103:20 Bless the Lord, you His angels,

Mighty in strength, who perform His word,

Obeying the voice of His word!

Jer 7:21 Thus says the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel, "Add your burnt offerings to your sacrifices and eat flesh. 22 For I did not speak to your fathers, or command them in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings and sacrifices. 23 But this is what I commanded them, saying, '**Obey My voice, and I will be your God, and you will be My people; and you will walk in all the way which I command you, that it may be well with you.**' 24 Yet they did not obey or incline their ear, but walked in their own counsels and in the stubbornness of their evil heart, and went backward and not forward. 27 "You shall speak all these words to them, but they will not listen to you; and you shall call to them, but they will not answer you. 28 You shall say to them, '**This is the nation that did not obey the voice of the Lord their God or accept correction; truth has perished and has been cut off from their mouth.**'

Jer 26:13 Now therefore "amend [h3190]" {to be (causative) make well, literally (sound, beautiful)] your ways and your deeds and **obey the voice of the Lord your God**; and the Lord will change His mind about the misfortune which He has pronounced against you. [REV]

Jer 40:3 and the Lord has brought it on and done just as He promised. **Because you people sinned against the Lord and did not listen to His voice**, therefore this thing has happened to you. [REV]

Jer 44:23 Because you have burned sacrifices and **have sinned against the Lord and not obeyed the voice of the Lord** or walked in His law, His statutes or His testimonies, therefore this calamity has befallen you, as it has this day."

Ezk 42:1 Then he led me to the gate, the gate facing toward the east; 2 and behold, the glory of

the God of Israel was coming from the way of the east. **And His voice was like the sound of many waters;** and the earth shone with His glory.

Dan 9:9, 14 To the Lord our God belong compassion and forgiveness, for we have rebelled against Him; **10 nor have we obeyed the voice of the Lord our God,** to walk in His teachings which He set before us through His servants the prophets.¹⁴ Therefore the Lord has kept the calamity in store and brought it on us; for the Lord our God is righteous with respect to all His deeds which He has done, **but we have not obeyed His voice.**

Joel 2:11 / John 10:4 **The Lord utters His voice before His army;**
When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them, and **the sheep follow him because they know his voice.**

NEW TESTAMENT

Mark 1:11 and a voice came out of the heavens: "You are My beloved Son, in You I am well-pleased."

Luke 11:27-28 While Jesus was saying these things, one of the women in the crowd raised her voice and said to Him, "Blessed is the womb that bore You and the breasts at which You nursed." **28** But He said, **"On the contrary, blessed are those who hear the word of God and observe it."**

John 5:24-25 / 28-29 "Truly, truly, I say to you, **he who hears My word,** and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life. **25** Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when **the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God,** and those who hear will live. **28** Do not marvel at this; for **an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice, 29 and will come forth;** those who did the good deeds to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil deeds to a resurrection of judgment. **30** *"I can do nothing on My own initiative. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is just, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.*

HEB 3:7-11 Therefore, just as the Holy Spirit says,
"Today if you hear His voice,
8 Do not harden your hearts as when they provoked Me,
As in the day of trial in the wilderness,
9 Where your fathers tried Me by testing Me,
And saw My works for forty years.
10 "Therefore I was angry with this generation,
And said, 'They always go astray in their heart,
And they did not know My ways';
11 As I swore in My wrath,
'They shall not enter My rest.'"

Heb 3:15 while it is said,
"Today if you hear His voice,
Do not harden your hearts, as when they provoked Me."

Heb 4:7 He again fixes a certain day, "Today," saying through David after so long a time just as has been said before,
"Today if you hear His voice,
Do not harden your hearts."

Rev 1:15 His feet were like burnished bronze, when it has been made to glow in a furnace, **and His voice was like the sound of many waters.**
